Day 1

Next head to the **American Rover** to sail on the Elizabeth River while enjoying cocktails and appetizers. Once you are back on land, you will head to dinner at the **Freemason Abbey**.

Day 2

Wake up to a fun-filled breakfast at the **Purple Cow**. The morning begins with a trip to the **Cape Henry Lighthouse** followed by a tour of the **Master Jet Base Oceana**. You will enjoy a hot buffet lunch at the **Officer's Club** before heading to outer space... or perhaps a visit to the **Virginia Air and Space Center**. Here you will take flight at the birthplace of America's space program and the official visitor center for NASA Langley Research Center. Enjoy an IMAX film on a giant screen before heading for a relaxing ride on the **Hampton Carousel**. The afternoon ends with a walk with the **pirates** through the streets of Hampton. Dinner will be along the beautiful waterfront.

Day 3

Following another energizing breakfast, you will head to **Olde Towne Portsmouth** for a "Trolley Tour" of this historic city. Portsmouth chronicles three hundred years of history in one of the largest collections of antique homes south of Alexandria. Your guide will be Portsmouth's founding father himself, **Colonel Crawford**. Following your tour you will have some time to explore the numerous antique and specialty shops as well as unique dining options right in a small walking area. Next we head to the **Virginia Living Museum** for a behind the scenes tour. Explore Virginia's natural heritage from the mountains to the sea with live exhibits that look back at you. Final stop will be the Mariners' Museum. This 63,500-square-foot facility thrills visitors with a high-definition battle theater, full-scale Monitor replica, interactive exhibits, and notable artifacts like the iconic rotating gun turret. "**Liberty Call! Liberty Call!**" is what you will hear next. Enjoy a fabulous night of dining and entertainment at the **Boxwood Inn** featuring the **Doorway Singer**.
